

Canterbury Cathedral Archives: U467-L/95/1/9 [Wallace Harvey collection] Will and Probate of Edith Annie Kemp, Spinster of Whitstable on Sea, dated 14th August 1925, who died 1st December 1925 and was Proved at Canterbury on 20th January 1926.

This is the last Will and Testament of me **Edith Annie Kemp** Spinster of 10 West Cliff Road of Whitstable on Sea in the County of Kent England made this 14 Aug 1925 day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty five

I hereby revoke all Wills by me made at anytime heretofore

I appoint Julia Dowley of 10 West Cliff Road Whitstable on Sea in the County of Kent England to be my Executor and direct that all my Debts and Funeral expenses shall be paid as soon as conveniently may be after my decease

I give and bequeath unto my Sisters Fanny Camburn Julia Dowley Kate Browning Martha Wraight Jenny Terry an equal share of my money at my decease

And be it further known that at the date hereunderwritten the last Will and Testament (a copy whereof hereunto annexed) of the said deceased was proved and registered in the District Probate Registry of His Majesty's High Court of Justice at Canterbury and that Administration of all the Estate which by law devolves to and vests in the personal representative of the said deceased was granted by the aforesaid Court to **Julie Dowley** (Wife of William Henry Dowley) the Sister of the said deceased the Sole Executrix named in the said Will

And it is hereby certified that an Affidavit for Inland Revenue has been delivered wherein it is shewn that the gross value of the said Estate within the United Kingdom (exclusive of what the said deceased may have been possessed of or entitled to as a Trustee and not beneficially) amounts to £187 - 14 - 3 And that the said Affidavit bears a Stamp of £1 - 1 - 0
